TRANSPORTATION:

We will travel together in a bus. Pastor Hadji Henderson along with other adults from the Youth Ministry will be attending the camp as counselors.

IMPORTANT:

Remember to bring money (\$10-15) for lunch on the way to and from camp. We'll stop where there are a number of fast-food restaurants.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES:

Please arrive at Calvary Chapel Modesto on Monday, July 10 at 9:00am sharp with luggage. We will meet by the maintenance building; students will stay there until our departure at 9:30am.

Limit baggage to one suitcase or clothing bag, and one sleeping bag or sheets & blankets set.

When checking-in, parents should notify Pastor Hadji of any special medical treatment or medication required through the duration of the camp. This information should also be noted on the Medical Release Form required for every student.

RETURNING TO CALVARY CHAPEL MODESTO:

We will be returning to Calvary Chapel on Saturday, July 15 at approximately 5:00pm. Please plan to pick up your son or daughter at this time at the church.

RULES

...It is our desire to provide students with an excellent time of fellowship, fun and most importantly, an opportunity to grow in the Lord. With as many students as we have, it is essential that we establish some basic rules of conduct so that these goals may be achieved. Please review these rules. Your compliance is expected and appreciated.

1. DON'T LEAVE CAMP! ALL activities must be supervised by a counselor.
2. Girls are NEVER allowed in the guys' cabins and guys are NEVER allowed in the girls' cabins. No "hanging out" around cabins either.
3. Everyone must be in their cabins by the designated times on the schedule.
4. All Bible studies, discussion groups, morning devotionals and group activities are MANDATORY.
5. Couples must refrain from ALL physical displays of affection toward one another. This includes hanging on each other, hand holding, hugging, kissing, etc.
6. Practical jokes are not permitted.
7. RESPECT! Treat all camp staff members, adults, and fellow students with mutual respect. Treat all camp facilities and camp grounds with respect.
You are financially responsible for any damages.

Failure to comply with these rules or to respect the authority of adult leaders will result in immediate dismissal from camp. Parents will be notified day or night and will be responsible for picking up the offending student.
