

## **Prayer Walks**

Here at YWAM San Francisco prayer plays such an important role in the daily life of ministry. We encourage teams to be a part of what God is doing here in San Francisco by praying as they walk through specific locations that we have mapped out.

## **Massage Parlor Prayer Walk**

Participants are taught about human trafficking in San Francisco. Then are sent out to pray over massage parlors in the neighborhood, we encourage them to pray for hope, healing and freedom.

## **Community Lunch**

Hospitality is one of the gifts we wish to foster in our participants. During community lunch participants have the opportunity of inviting people off the streets and into the YWAM base to serve and share meals with people they have connected with on the streets.

## **Glide Memorial**

Glide is a hub of resources for the community of the Tenderloin. Our groups are often able to partner with them through volunteering in their dining room which serves on average about 2,000 meals per Day.

## **Neighborhood Cleanup**

During this activity we spend time building relationships with store owners in our neighborhood, by going and being the hands and feet of Christ as we serve them in practical ways.

## **Hot Chocolate**

Hot Chocolate Nights are longest standing tradition here at YWAM SF. We are known in the neighborhood for our red & blue jugs that carry hot chocolate to our friends on the street. We strive to share the Love of Jesus one cup at a time by reminding people that they are valued and what they have to say matters. It's an exciting activity that allows for us to pray and listen to our friends on the street.

## **Sack Lunch**

For this outreach we pack two lunches - one for ourselves and one for a friend. We then set out into a part of the city to enjoy their company, hear their stories and share the gospel.
